



**Addendum to PowerSupply Coordination®
Service Agreement
Make Me Green™ Voluntary Renewable Energy
Certificates**

This is an addendum to the December 31, 2014 (DATE) PowerSupply Coordination® Agreement ("Agreement") between Direct Energy Business, LLC ("Direct Energy") and ULSTER COUNTY ("Buyer") to accommodate Buyer's December 31, 2014 (date) purchase of Renewable Energy Certificates or "RECs" from Direct Energy. All of the terms and conditions of the PSC Agreement are incorporated by reference into this Addendum. A REC is a commodity that represents the environmental attributes associated with electricity delivered into a power grid in North America by a Renewable Resource. "Renewable Resource" means one or more generators producing electric power from solar, wind, geothermal, biomass, hydropower, or other source meeting the requirements for "Eligible Renewable" as provided in the Green-e Renewable National Standard or an applicable alternative renewable resource certification program. Buyer has elected to voluntarily offset carbon emissions associated with a targeted percentage of its estimated annual electricity use with the following type and quantity of RECs:

* Based upon reasonably estimated historical usage.

REC Purchase Period: The REC Purchase Period shall be from February (month) 1 (day), 2015 to January (month) 31 (day), 2017. Direct Energy may take up to 3 months following the end of the REC Purchase Period to acquire the RECs Buyer is purchasing.

Green-e Certification: Yes

Billing Option: Single Invoice Invoice through REC Purchase Period:

The price for Buyer's REC purchase appears in the table above and is in addition to the Price which is paid pursuant to the terms of the PSC Agreement. Unless otherwise noted above, Buyer will be sent a one-time invoice for its REC purchase. Payment shall be made pursuant to the terms stated on the invoice. Upon request, Direct Energy will provide Buyer with a certificate reflecting the REC purchase. Title to the RECs passes to Buyer when Direct Energy receives payment in full for the RECs. Buyer acknowledges and agrees that: (i) the RECs are separate and apart from any electricity purchased and, therefore, this REC purchase transaction is not a transaction in electricity; (ii) by purchasing the RECs, Buyer is not purchasing renewable electricity from Direct Energy; and (iii) the Renewable Resource may deliver electricity into any power grid in North America.
