Hello Niklas,

On 3/8, I received CSCC doc from Rita from Bethel for four different actions: 1.1, 1.2, 2.2, and 6.6. Nothing from Tusten yet.

Neither Bethel nor Tusten submitted any CSCC doc prior to 3/8.

All doc is reviewed on a case-by-case basis, so I cannot make any guarantees of points earned until the review is complete. However, the Mid-Hudson GHG inventory can be the basis for 2.2 provided it is submitted soon (to stay within the 5-year eligibility timeframe) and provided the doc is a report, not just a spreadsheet. It can be a short report, but it should have some narrative text that shows some level of reflection on the results of the inventory and how those results relate to the community's priorities.
