The Town of Greenburgh, through the Greenburgh Police Department, created a Mitigation Plan for the Town and six Villages (Ardsley, Dobbs Ferry, Elmsford, Hastings-on-Hudson, Irvington and Tarrytown).

The plan includes the following points:
