WHEREAS, the Oregon Road, Red Mill Road, Westbrook Drive Roundabout project was completed last year and is an effective traffic control device improving a complicated 5-way intersection and also is an attractive addition to the area which was partially funded by a private developer and with money from the New York State DOT.
