WHEREAS, Kingston is desirous of investigating methods to address and reduce such threats; and



SECTION-1. The Common Council of the City of Kingston hereby adopts the annexed Climate Smart and Green Jobs Community Pledge.


SECTION-2. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
