The City of Kingston has begun a new initiative focusing on large public gatherings and increasing recycling rates at those events. For all events taking place in the Rondout District of Kingston, the Department of Public Works will park its recycling trailer, offering receptacles for public use. For other events around Kingston that the city co-sponsors, the Department of Public Works will require that co-sponsoring groups or agencies provide the necessary recycling containers for DPW to pick up along with the events garbage. The Department of Public Works, Code Enforcement Officer will enforce all rules regarding recycling at these events.
