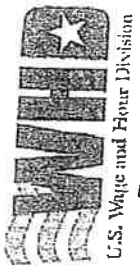

While completion of Form WH-347 is optional, it is mandatory for covered contractors and subcontractors performing work on Federally financed or assisted construction contracts to respond to the information collection contained in 29 C.F.R. §§ 3.3, 5.5(b). The Copeland Act (40 U.S.C. § 3146) contractors and subcontractors performing work on Federally financed or assisted construction contracts to "furnish weekly a statement with respect to the wages paid each employee during the preceding week." U.S. Department of Labor (DOL) regulations at 29 C.F.R. § 5.5(a)(3)(ii) require contractors to submit weekly a copy of all payrolls to the Federal agency contracting for or financing the construction project, accompanied by a signed "Statement of Compliance" indicating that the payrolls are correct and complete and that each laborer or mechanic has been paid not less than the proper Davis-Bacon prevailing wage rate for the work performed. DOL and federal contracting agencies receiving this information review the information to determine that employees have received legally required wages and fringe benefits.

Dear Mr. Niles

This is to advise that after full evaluation of the street tree bids, the City of Kingston has decided to award the bid to your company as submitted.

Attached is a copy for the contracted numbers. As we discussed, all terms and conditions as set forth in the Contract RFQ must be adhered to (i.e. - Certified Payrolls, Prevailing Wage Rates, Insurance naming the City as additionally insured). The purchase will also expand the number of trees to 24 in total, adding one additional of each species as follows:

- Six (6) *Crataegus Viridis* Winterking Hawthorn, 2.5" Caliper, installed to spec., includes HDPE Root Barrier @ \$469.95/ea..
- Six (6) *Ulmus Americana* Elm, 2.5" Caliper, installed to spec., includes HDPE Root Barrier @ \$479.95/ea.
- Six (6) *Celtis Occidentalis* Common Hackberry, 2.5" Caliper, installed to spec., includes HDPE Root Barrier @ \$479.95/ea.
- Six (6) *Quercus Imbricari* Shingle Oak, 2.5" Caliper, installed to spec., includes HDPE Root Barrier @ \$498.95/ea.
- TOTAL Cost: \$11,572.80

Upon completion and acceptance, the final bill, accompanied by appropriate documentation should be made to the Kingston Community Development Agency. However, we request that it be mailed to the Office of Planning to be verified prior to processing payment.

Please contact the City Planning Office to confirm locations and planting types.
