What is the ReUse Center?

The Town of New Paltz's Reuse and Recycling Center provides consumers with the option of purchasing used items in order to divert reusable materials from the waste stream back into the home of the consumer.

New Paltz's mission goes beyond recycling; reuse is more conducive to achieving Zero Waste. Laura Petit, Coordinator of the ReUse Center, stresses the importance of reuse as opposed to the other alternatives: *"Our goal is to educate everyone about sustainable materials management. Reuse is one of the ways to keep good materials out of the waste stream that are destined for landfills five hours away. By modifying our consumerism to reduce what we buy then use and reuse, we not only achieve our zero waste goals but reduce our carbon footprint too."*
