### Market Street Sidewalk and Curb

- Saw cut existing pavement as needed
- Remove existing pavement, sidewalks, curbs, and soil
- Form and pour 690± LF of concrete curb 6" x 8" x 18" non-reinforced.
- Form and pour 690 ±LF of 5' wide concrete sidewalk – 6" item 4 subbase, 4" concrete 4,000 psi, 6 X 6 X 10 wire mesh, expansion joints every 20'
- Blacktop repair in front of curb and where driveways or paths are crossed
- Disturbed areas to receive topsoil and seed

### Montgomery Street Mill and Fill

- Mill existing roadway 2,590 LF in length and 25 FT wide for the most part to a depth of 2"
- Furnish and apply tack coat at an application rate of .15 gal/SY

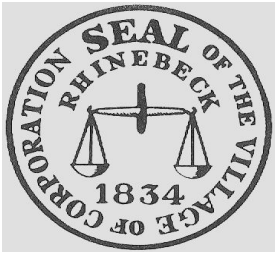

**Rhinebeck, NY-** Tuesday October 10, 2017 at 6:00 PM Mayor Gary Bassett along with the Rhinebeck Village Board and Members of the Frost Memorial Foundation, will be officially opening the new 690+/- sidewalk located on West Market Street in the Village of Rhinebeck with a ribbon cutting. The construction of this sidewalk was made possible thanks to a grant received from the Frost Memorial Fund, Inc. The sidewalk extends from the Thompson Mazzarella Park 690 feet toward the center of the village.
