- In September of 2018, Marbletown hired Civic Plus to revamp the town website. The three-year payment was \$3,326.67, working out to \$92.39 per month.

- Links to categories or specific documents are all located on the main page. For example, “[Recycling and Composting](#)” leads to a secondary page with multiple documents included.
- The link titled “[Town Resource Reports and Planning](#)” in the upper-left column leads to the town’s collection of adopted plans and studies.
