## GENERAL INFORMATION

### PAYMENT

The Transfer Station does not accept cash. Any fees at the Transfer Station must be paid by check, payable to "Town of Marbletown." You can purchase permits and punch cards by cash or check in the Town Clerk's Office at The Rondout Municipal Center, 1925 Lucas Ave., Cottekill, NY 12419. Phone: 845-687-7601 ext. 6.

### PERMITS

Annual permits are how you gain access to the Transfer Station. You can purchase them by check at the Transfer Station or by cash or check at the Municipal Center. Permits are valid for 1 year, starting April 1<sup>st</sup>. All permits expire March 31<sup>st</sup>. Single-day permits are available and must be purchased at the Municipal Center.

### ONCE YOU HAVE A PERMIT

All non-recyclable waste is taken on a "pay-as-you-throw" basis. You can recycle items at no charge, although please remember that some items you might think are recyclable are actually not.

### PUNCH CARDS

To avoid multiple transactions, you can buy one or more \$20 punch cards. These are available by check at the Transfer Station, or by cash or check at the Municipal Center. There are no senior discounts for punch cards.

Thank you for helping us maintain a safe, friendly and efficient community Transfer Station.

### HAZARDOUS MATERIALS

Are not accepted. Please call Ulster County Resource Recovery Agency at 845-336-0600 for information on safe hazardous materials disposal.

### COMMERCIAL DEBRIS

Commercial construction/demolition debris is not accepted. Ulster County Resource Recovery has specific sites in Kingston and New Paltz for these items. Call 845-336-6893 for the Kingston site or 845-255-6358 for the New Paltz site.

The only construction/demolition debris accepted is a limited amount by individual homeowners.

### METAL

No metal materials are to leave the Transfer Station. Scrap metal is a source of revenue for the residents of Marbletown. Reusable items, such as bicycles, working appliances, etc. will be made available to the public at the discretion of the Transfer Station Team Leader.

### FIRE AND RESCUE

Volunteer fire departments each receive 15 free permits plus two \$20 punch cards. The Marbletown Volunteer First Aid and Rescue Squad receives 15 free permits plus two \$20 punch cards. Each fire department and the Squad need to give the Town Clerk its list of volunteers.

### TRASH FROM FUNDRAISERS AND EVENTS

The Transfer Station will accept it for free. A written pass from the Town Clerk is required.
