Whereas, a Climate Smart Communities Coordinator will serve as a point of contact for the Climate Smart Communities (CSC) program and facilitate project implementation.

Whereas, establishment of a Climate Smart Communities Task Force serves as a central body of leadership that promotes and supports the local government to accomplish plans, programs, and activities that are part of the Climate Smart Communities Certification program.

Whereas, the Broome County Environmental Management Council serves as the advisory body to County government on local environmental issues as established by the Broome County Charter and Code.

Now, therefore, I, Jason T. Garnar, County Executive of the County of Broome, do hereby order and direct the following:

1. It shall be the responsibility of the Senior Planner in the Department of Planning and Economic Development to serve as the Climate Smart Communities Coordinator.
2. The Broome County Environmental Management Council is designated as the Broome County Climate Smart Communities Task Force for the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation's Climate Smart Communities program.
