RED HOOK RECYCLING CENTER REGULATIONS

- 1. YOU MUST BE A TOWN RESIDENT AND HAVE A VALID PERMIT AFFIXED PROPERLY TO THE WINDSHIELD OF YOUR VEHICLE TO USE THE FACILITY. A PERMIT MAY BE OBTAINED FROM THE TOWN CLERK IN THE TOWN HALL FROM 9AM TO 4PM MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY.
- 2. ANYONE ATTEMPTING TO USE THE FACILITY WITHOUT A PERMIT WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE IMMEDIATELY.
- 3. ANY QUESTIONS CONCERNING RECYCLING SHOULD BE ADDRESSED TO THE MANAGER OR AN EMPLOYEE.
- 4. THE MANAGER'S DECISIONS ARE FINAL.
- 5. USERS MUST LIMIT THEIR TIME AT THE RECYCLING CENTER TO NO MORE THAN ONE-HOUR PER DAY. THE MANAGER HAS THE RIGHT TO ASK ANYONE TO LEAVE AT ANY TIME.
- 6. ALL ITEMS BROUGHT TO THE GOODS EXCHANGE SHALL BE OFFERED TO THE GENERAL PUBLIC ON A FIRST COME, FIRST SERVED BASIS. THERE SHALL BE NO SAVING OF ITEMS FOR A PARTICULAR PERSON.
- 7. ONLY THE STAFF OR AUTHORIZED VOLUNTEERS ARE TO ASSIST WITH ITEMS TO BE LEFT AT THE RECYCLING CENTER. DONATIONS ARE TO BE SORTED AND DISTRIBUTED BY THE STAFF OR AUTHORIZED VOLUNTEERS ONLY.
- 8. NO ONE IS PERMITTED ON OR IN A DUMPSTER.
