PARKS RECYCLING PROGRAM GUIDELINES

Park Managers and Staff

- Blue recycling bins should be placed next to the trash cans. If they are moved away from trash cans, please place them back directly next to the trash can.
- Blue bins should be handled with care. Damage to the recycling bin or cover should be reported.
- Clear plastic bags must be used in the recycling bins. Black bags are to be used for trash only. Using black trash bags will convey that recycling is not being separated properly.
- Collected recycling must be placed in the designated central recycling container.

The designated container is serviced by Taylor Garbage service.

• Contamination issues

It is anticipated there will be some level of contamination. The quantity of contamination will determine if the material can still be recycled. The clear bag will allow for a quick visual inspection.

- If approximately a quarter or more of the bag of recycling has <u>food waste</u>, <u>foam plates</u>, <u>paper plates or plastic bags</u> mixed in the material is too contaminated to recycle.
- Beverage bottle containers with liquid still in them are expected and should not be considered as contamination.

• Materials not accepted as recycling:

- Foam & paper plates
- Food waste
- Plastic bags & film
- Foam & plastic cups
- Paper napkins
