The Following is taken from the Montour Falls Sustainability Committee guidance document on public engagement and promotional campaigns:

- 1) Provide Village support to the Montour Falls Farmers Market to promote it as an important outlet for local producers and an important resource for Village residents.
 - a) The Farmers Market takes place in the same pocket park as the Village Electric Vehicle Charger:
 - i) The Farmers Market can, in collaboration with Sustainable Montour Falls and the Village government, host an Electric Vehicle Demonstration to coincide with a market day, increasing visibility both of Montour Falls' commitment to EV technology, but also raising visibility for the Farmers Market and all they provide.
 - b) The Village can provide visibility and accessibility by promoting the Farmers Market on social media.
 - i) By advertising as a partner of the Village and Sustainable Montour Falls, the Farmers Market will reach new audiences both for producers and vendors, and shoppers.
 - (1) This includes participation in the Sustainable Montour Falls business and community partnerships listed elsewhere in this document.
