

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF KINGSTON COMMON COUNCIL TO ADOPT THE
COMPREHENSIVE PLAN FOR THE CITY OF KINGSTON

WHEREAS, the City of Kingston is considering the adoption of an updated Comprehensive Plan for the City of Kingston (the "Project") dated March 15, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the Council adopted Resolution #56 of 2016 which documented the environmental process, directed required filings and distribution, which have subsequently been accomplished and concluded; and

WHEREAS, the Council has adopted a resolution to certify, accept, circulate and maintain the Environmental Findings in accordance with Article 8 of the Environmental Conservation Law of New York State, 6NYCRR, Section 617; and

WHEREAS, the Council held a public hearing on November 19, 2015 and has considered all comment; and

WHEREAS, the Council has received copies of the Comprehensive Plan, along with Findings and a copy of the filed Notice of Completion; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF KINGSTON COMMON COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the March 15 2016 Comprehensive Plan, as presented, is consistent with the Environmental Findings as adopted and certified; and is hereby adopted as provided under §28-a of General City Law.


Section 2: That the March 15, 2016 Comprehensive Plan appropriately balances potential adverse impacts against potential beneficial impacts in the forms of creation of additional housing opportunities, enhancement of transportation efficiency, promotion of economic development, and the generation of tax revenue as well as lessening of the tax burden, protection of natural resources and improving the quality of life of City residents and business owners.


