RE: **Installation of Cool/Green Roofing Material on new or renovated flat roofs on County Facilities**


The consumption of energy in Suffolk County buildings continues to be a large and growing budget concern. Research and case studies have demonstrated that cool roofs and green roofs can help reduce energy costs and stormwater runoff. Suffolk County has been a leader in environmental policy and energy conservation initiatives.

Therefore, pursuant to Sections 3-2, 3-3, 3-4, and 4-2 of the SUFFOLK COUNTY CHARTER, you are hereby authorized, empowered, and directed to consider and evaluate the installation of cool and/or green roof technologies in the scope, budget, and subsequent construction of any roofing design and construction project that repairs, renovates or retrofits a flat roof on a County facility.

This Executive Order applies to all County-owned buildings except for those currently under construction or those funded in the Adopted 2012 Capital Budget.

This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.

Pursuant to Sections 3-2, 3-3, 3-4, 4-2 of the Suffolk County Charter, you are hereby authorized, empowered, and directed to include in the scope, budget, and subsequent construction of any new building design and construction project, the installation of photovoltaic panels and associated appurtenances such as conduit, inverters, power monitors, etc., for the purposes of generating no less than 5% of the anticipated peak electrical load of the building. The photovoltaic system may be installed on any surface of the building, integrated into the building components or may be located on the same site in the form of carports, grade installations on frames, or other industry standard means.

This Executive Order applies to all new County owned buildings over 10,000 square feet in size except for those currently under construction or those funded in the Adopted 2010 Capital Budget.
