

Education and Training Contract

TRAINING PROVIDER: SUFFOLK COUNTY COMMUNITY COLLEGE

TRAINING PROGRAM: COMPREHENSIVE BPI ENERGY ANALYST & ENVELOPE PROGRAM

I. The CONTRACTOR will provide the following, all of which are included in the cost entered in Item II(A) of this addendum:

A. The supplies, books, tools, uniforms, and/or equipment which will be retained by the participant upon successful completion of the course; fees for licensing or certification tests necessary for completion of the course; any other items necessary to complete the course.

B. A course of instruction consisting of:

This course will cover the basic principles of building science, efficacy of building and insulating materials, energy efficiency and advanced envelope/shell principles. Will learn to quantify building performance and prescribe improvements to help tighten the building envelope (shell), stop uncontrolled air leakage and optimize comfort and durability through insulation and HV/AC performance. Hands-on efficiency testing experiences will be provided. All required materials are provided. Aligned with the Building Performance Institute's (BPI) nationally recognized exam(s).

TRAINING PROGRAM: HIGH SCHOOL EQUIVALENCY PLUS SOLAR INSTALLER

- I. The CONTRACTOR will provide the following, all of which are included in the cost entered in Item II(A) of this addendum:
- A. The supplies, books, tools, uniforms, and/or equipment which will be retained by the participant upon successful completion of the course; fees for licensing or certification tests necessary for completion of the course; any other items necessary to complete the course.

Textbooks, lab materials and National Certification Test.

- B. A course of instruction consisting of:

Develop career skills while earning a High School Equivalency credential. Solar Technology training will cover basic solar energy principles, photovoltaics and solar panel installation. This course prepares students to take the NABCEP certification. It is the student's responsibility to schedule this test. College level math is required in this course. Math assessment is provided and students that do not meet course qualifications will take a Math Brush Up course. Students will also receive instruction to prepare for the Test Assessing Secondary Completion (TASC). Students who pass the TASC earn their High School Equivalency. The TASC class meets twice a week for 3 hours each class. Students must take an assessment test and must score at 9th grade or above in reading and math.
