

Education and Training Contract

This Contract ("Contract") is between the County of Suffolk ("County"), a municipal corporation of the State of New York, acting through its duly constituted Department of Labor, Licensing & Consumer Affairs ("Department"), located at Building 17, North County Complex, 725 Veterans Memorial Highway, Hauppauge, New York 11788; and

TRAINING PROVIDER: United Way of Long Island, Inc

TRAINING PROGRAM: Green Construction Efficiency Technician

I. The CONTRACTOR will provide the following, all of which are included in the cost entered in Item II(A) of this addendum:

A. The supplies, books, tools, uniforms, and/or equipment which will be retained by the participant upon successful completion of the course; fees for licensing or certification tests necessary for completion of the course; any other items necessary to complete the course.

B. A course of instruction consisting of:

- Introduction to diagnostic testing processes and equipment
- Emphasis on health, safety and durability of residential energy improvements
- Understanding of measuring and inspecting a home for home energy audits
- Applying BPI standards during field inspection
- Developing competency using the nanometer, blower door system, gas sniffer, infrared camera and completing combustions safety tests according to BPI standards
- Develop a work scope based on the practice audits
