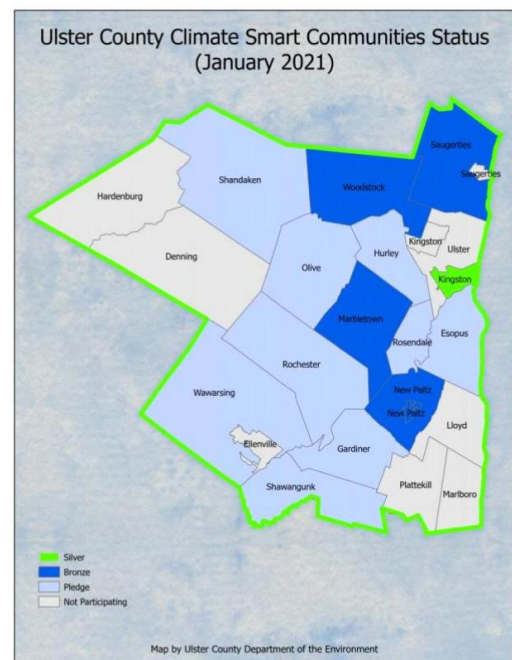
Ulster County Climate Smart Committee

Woodstock has been an active collaborator with the Ulster County Climate Smart Committee (CSC) since November 2014. The committee was established by Ulster County Legislative Resolution #185 of August 16, 2011 to further the objectives of the Climate Smart Community Pledge adopted by Ulster County Legislative Resolution #184 of August 16, 2011.

The Climate Smart Committee has five members, appointed by the legislative chairman and hold their positions during the term of the legislature. The committee meets monthly and provides a forum for Ulster County communities that have taken the climate smart pledge to share their experiences, progress, problems, and opportunities in implementation of the pledge.

Woodstock submits a monthly report summarizing its climate smart activities to the committee and the communities participating in the climate smart program before each meeting. These reports are also provided to the Woodstock Town Board, Woodstock Environmental Commission, Woodstock Land Conservancy, Woodstock Transition Working Group Council, and other interested parties.

Attached in this PE submission are Woodstock's CSC monthly reports for 2020. Also available upon request are reports and documents submitted in the years 2015 through 2019.
