

## PE5 Recycling Bins in Government Buildings

Westchester County properties were divided into types according to their category (i.e. park, golf course, administrative building, etc). Attached to this document are pictures taken from at least one property in each of the seven groupings to demonstrate that each trash bin is paired with a recycling bin at these County-owned locations.

### Park:

Saxon Woods (1800 Mamaroneck Ave, White Plains, NY 10605)

At Saxon Woods, there are two types of waste bin pairings, both including a trash can and a recycling bin for glass and plastics. One of the pairings (left) has a trash can with an open top and the trash can in the other (right) has a lid.



Playland (1 Playland Pkwy, Rye, NY 10580)

At Playland Park, the County-owned amusement park in Westchester, there are paired trash cans and recycling bins for plastic, glass, and cans throughout the park, as shown below.



### Administrative Building:

Michaelian Office Building (148 Martine Ave, White Plains, NY 10601)

In the County-owned administrative buildings, there are various types of bin combinations depending on their location. In common areas including kitchens, there are typically three bins found together: waste, paper recycling, and plastic/metal/glass recycling. These bins are found in the first two pictures. In offices and more private spaces, there are usually two bins, one for waste and one for recyclables, as shown in the bottom picture.



**Golf Course:**

Maple Moor Golf Course (1128 North St, White Plains, NY 10605)

Westchester-owned golf courses have paired bins like the one below, with a can for general waste and one for recyclable materials.



**Farm:**

Hilltop Hanover Farm (1271 Hanover St, Yorktown Heights, NY 10598)

At Hilltop Hanover Farm, one of two farms run by Westchester County, there are two sets of four waste bins for public use. The four bins from left to right are cans and bottles, paper, trash, and compost.



**Education:**

Westchester Community College (75 Grasslands Rd, Valhalla, NY 10595)

At Westchester Community College, there are several variations of waste collection bins. There are two variations of three-bin combinations: one outdoor variation and two indoor variations. The first (left) includes one bin for trash, one for commingled plastics, glass, and metal, and one for paper. The second structure with three bins has trash, paper, and cans (middle). There are also pairing with two bins, that includes a bin for general trash and one for cans/bottles (right).



**Airport:**

Westchester County Airport (240 Airport Road, White Plains, NY 10604)

At the County Airport, there are trash and recycling bin pairs located throughout the airport. The first picture is the trash and recycling bin pairs outside the airport and the other two are indoor trash and recycling bins. The recycling is for bottles and cans, as shown below.



**Community Building:**

Westchester Community Center (198 Central Avenue, White Plains, NY 10606)

The County Center has indoor(left) and outdoor (right) trash and recycling bins. The recycling bins are for cans and bottles, as indicated below.
