

Seneca Bluffs Maintenance Activities

- Monthly shoreline sweeps and trash collection (April – October)
 - o Volunteers spend 3 hours on each Saturday cleaning up trash, including plastics and Styrofoam, from the shoreline

- Volunteer planting days
 - o Native trees and herbaceous plants are used to supplement failed plantings along the shoreline

- Invasive species monitoring and control
 - o Licensed herbicide applicator contracted for work at the park
 - o Manual removal days with volunteers
 - o Release of purple loosestrife beetles

- Wildlife exclosures installed to protect establishing plants from predation
