Documentation should be dated and include the name of the applying jurisdiction, and may consist of one or more of the following: a press release, a flyer from an event hosted by the jurisdiction, a website screenshot, a local press article, a certified resolution, or comparable information.
- Submit a completed Customer List (a template is available in the Community Campaigns toolkit at [www.nyserda.ny.gov/cec](http://www.nyserda.ny.gov/cec)) that includes the required number of customers. The Customer List must include the location, name of the installer/supplier, and either the date contract was signed, the date the project was installed or vehicle purchased, the date the installation was permitted, or the date the NY Sun, Ground Source Heat Pump Rebate, Air Source Heat Pump Program, or Renewable Heat NY application was submitted. Installation / purchase dates must be after the launch date of the campaign to qualify. Customers must reside within the boundaries of the applying jurisdiction.
