Items must be approved by Compactor employees. Compactor employees have the right to refuse any item. Items are not to be taken for resale.

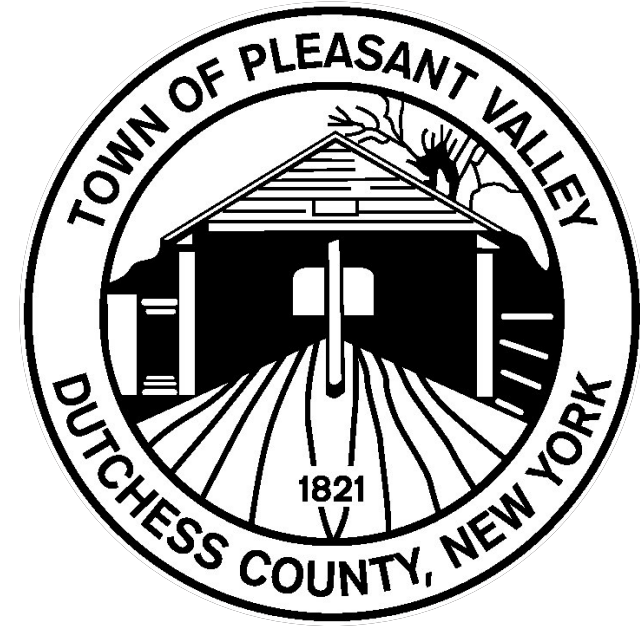


Waste Reduction Ideas

\$18.00 Senior, Veteran, Active Military
(Must show valid ID)

Rules and Guidelines:

- Seniors (60 yrs and older), Veterans, and Active Military receive **25%** discount at purchase. Must show valid ID.
- TWO SENIORS** refuse tickets can be purchased **EVERY THREE WEEKS.**
- Residents can purchase regular refuse tickets at any time.
- Checks at the compactor will only be accepted when accompanied by ID and the appropriate refuse ticket (name, address, and phone number must be on the check)
- Absolutely **NO CASH** accepted, at any time, at the compactor.

Refuse / Bulk Rates

Household Trash

\$5.00- 1 Bag or Can, 33 gallons or less
\$7.00- 1 Bag or Can, more than 33 gallons

Bulk

\$10.00- Wooden chair
\$15.00- Recliner or upholstered chair
\$20.00- Sofa
\$25.00- Sleeper sofa
\$25.00- 9'x12' rug
\$25.00- Refrigerator, freezer (doors removed)*
***Freon appliances must have compressor intact**
\$25.00- A/C units, dehumidifiers*
***Freon appliances must have compressor intact**

Computers, Peripherals, TVs and Electronics

\$10.00- Computers (small servers, laptops, desktops, e-readers, and tablets)
\$25.00- Televisions (up to 50", flat-screen and cathode ray tubes)
\$50.00- Televisions (large projection over 50")
\$2.00- Keyboards, portable digital music player
\$1.00- Mouse, handheld gaming device (each)
\$5.00- Fax, scanner, printer
\$4.00- VCR, DVR, DVD, blu-ray player and cable box consoles

Batteries

\$2.00- Drill or similar, AA, AAA, C, D, 9-volt
\$1.00- Hearing aid/ watch, 10 for \$1.00

Tires

\$30.00- Small vehicle, car, or truck
\$50.00- Large truck or tractor

Recycling

No Additional Charge

- **Recyclables-** glass, plastic, cardboard-flattened, junk mail, magazines, and aluminum (please rinse thoroughly all jars and cans).
- **Newspaper-** collected by BSA Troop #33 in the building behind the compactor booth. Please bundle for ease of transport.
- **Metal-** scrap metal, small appliances, metal tools, wire, machinery, propane tanks (valve removed), steel I-beams (6' length max)
***NOTE:** metal subject to change due to market
- **Deposit bottles and cans-** collected 2nd Saturday of each month. Fundraiser for BSA Troop #55.

NOT ACCEPTED

Fuel, motor oil, septic tanks, gasoline tanks, complete vehicles, hazardous waste, construction debris, oil based paint cans, railroad ties, treated lumber, tree stumps, brush, rocks, metal longer than 6'.
