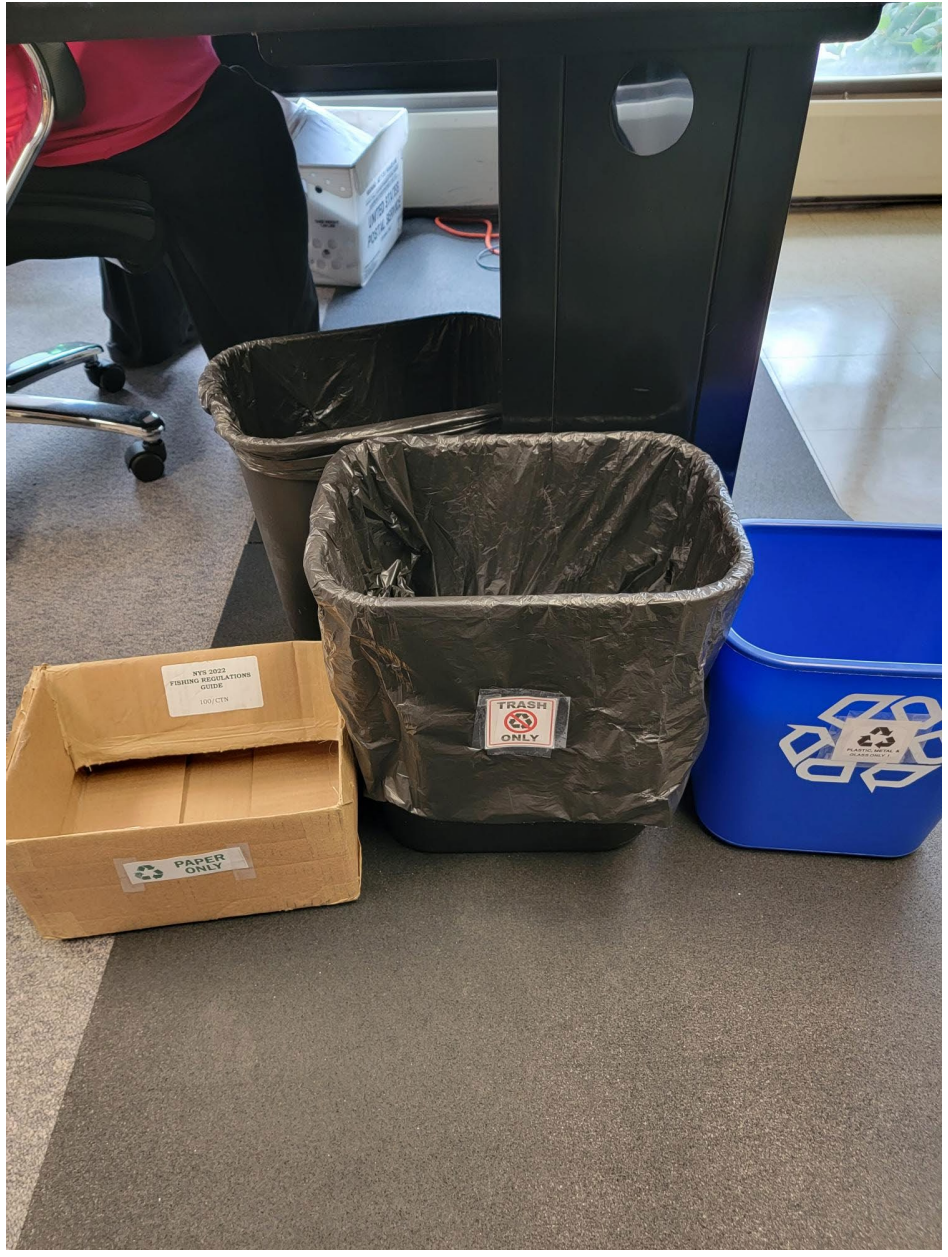

Please be aware that the Climate Smart Task Force has introduced a recycling initiative within all town buildings.

Soon blue recycling bins will be appearing in your workspaces.

The bins should be utilized for recyclable plastic, glass, and metal. Please be sure the recyclables are cleaned before placing them in the bins.

Simple boxes will also be appearing, if they are not there already, for collection of paper only; not corrugated items, those can be left near the blue bins.

The maintenance department will be collecting the recyclables on a regular basis and bringing them to the transfer station for processing. Please be sure you are only placing clean recyclable items in the blue bins and other trash in regular bins so that maintenance does not have to sift through the blue bins removing incorrect items.

When we recycle, natural resources are saved. Recycling also saves energy. Recycling reduces greenhouse gas emissions, by reducing the amount of energy that is used by industry as opposed to raw materials and helps stem the dangers of global climate change.

Re: Recycling Policy Town Buildings

WHEREAS, the Town of Pleasant Valley believes that recycling is important for reducing energy use and is committed to providing a convenient way for employees to recycle, and

WHEREAS, we believe that people are more likely to recycle if recycling vessels are placed in common areas near standard trash bins or in employees' general work environments to ensure visibility, ease of use and convenience;

Now therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the Town of Pleasant Valley will place recycling bins next to trash bins enabling employees a convenient way to recycle glass, plastic and metal and recycling cardboard boxes wherever possible for paper recycling in Town owned buildings and will undertake the responsibility by providing said recycling vessels and informing all employees, by way of the attached memo, of these actions and policy.
