SOLAR FEASIBILITY STUDY (need to map out path forward once there is a structural analysis)

CIR: Shade elements and components

Roof is literally leaking into building

CPL = engineering design on roof w/ possible solar panel additions

CIR = comes down to economics – what is currently being paid; cost-effectiveness of installation

Will need for feasibility study: structural analysis (CPL) & some economic analysis (bidding?)

### SHADE STRUCTURES POLICY

Took down structures at Fireman's Park; bus stations not covered

Playground has shelter over new fitness equipment

New project – considering native tree species

Discussion re replacing mature trees w/ more than one: consider all public spaces (not just ROW), could be replaced in multiple sites; might not replace with just small trees

Community input through the Climate Smart Task Force

Recommendations for implementation: Dept. heads, Beautification Committee, CSC Task Force
