

Bicycle and Pedestrian Infrastructure: Bicycle Lanes and Signage

Between Pleasant and Hinchey avenues, Central Avenue was striped with road markings that clearly define travel, bike and parking lanes in 2019. There is an 8-foot-wide parking lane on the east side of the street; one 10-foot-wide travel lane in each direction separated by a double-yellow line; and 5-foot-wide bike lanes running both north and south. Signage calling attention to the new bike lanes was also installed.
