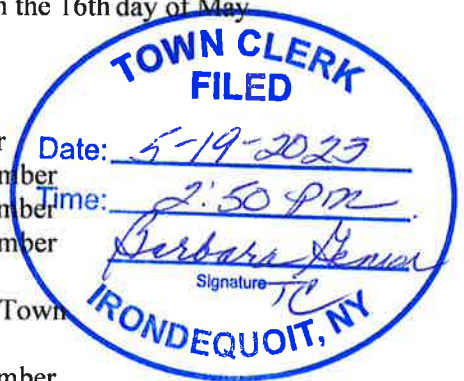

Town Board Member Romeo offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, the Town of Irondequoit has made a pledge to become a Climate Smart community and is currently taking actions to become officially certified by New York State as a Climate Smart community; and

WHEREAS, the Town’s 2014 Comprehensive Master Plan and 2017 Active Transportation Plan endorse the concept known as “complete streets,” which are streets that provide a safe and attractive environment for all ages and abilities and all forms of transportation including auto, public transit, pedestrian, and bicycle; and

WHEREAS, “Complete Streets” are streets that are planned, designed, operated and maintained to enable safe access for all users; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Irondequoit will strive to support the development of a connected network of roadways and/or pathways, accommodating each mode of travel that is consistent with and supportive of the local community, recognizing that all streets are different and that the needs of various users will need to be balanced in a flexible manner; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board and the Irondequoit Climate Smart Task Force urges the Town Planning Board to incorporate this Complete Streets policy into its work to the extent feasible and appropriate; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Board hereby declares adopts the Complete Streets Policy set forth in Addendum “A” which is attached hereto.

This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
