PE5 Residential Organic Waste Programs

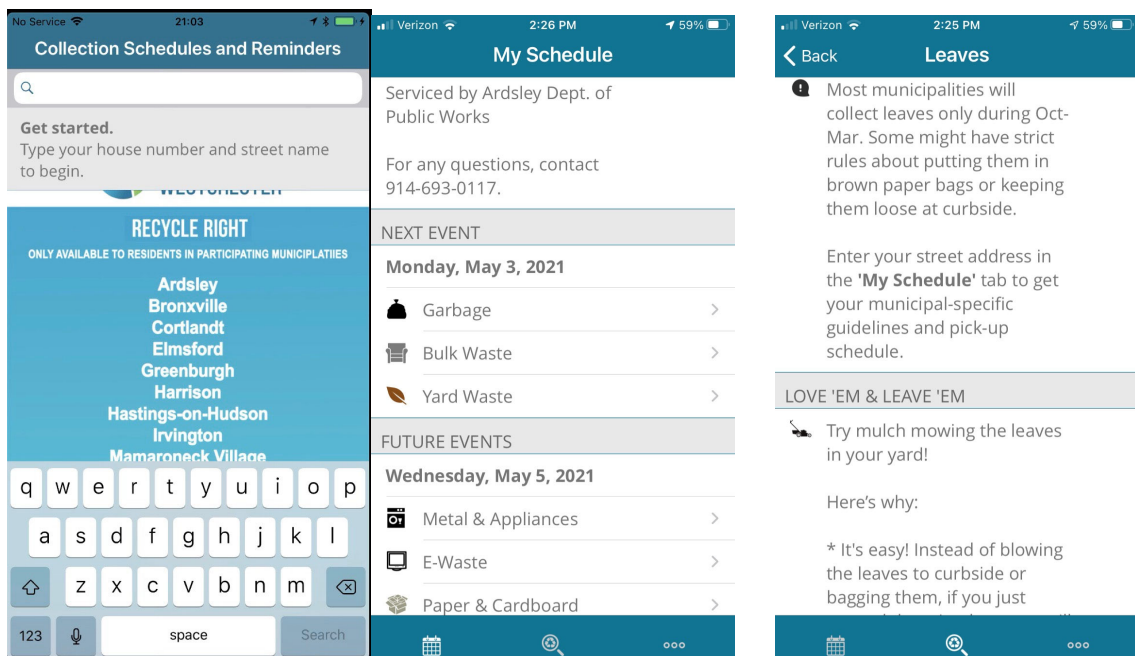
The Ardsley Department of Public Works (DPW) employs approximately 8 people, and is responsible for a range of work streams including sanitation and recycling. The DPW manages the Ardsley curbside Yard Waste Program and the Village of Ardsley also offers a drop-off Food Scrap Recycling Program as a Village within the Town of Greenburgh.

Yard Waste

The DPW collects leaves and yard waste at residential curbsides. The DPW carts this waste to a transfer station in Yonkers, which serves as the host given an Intermunicipal Agreement with Westchester County Solid Waste.

In the spring and fall, the DPW collects leaves and yard waste on a schedule that is made available to residents. In order to participate in this program, residents must place waste in paper bags, with branches tied or taped. Bundles heavier than 40 pounds are not accepted.

In August 2020 the Village of Ardsley launched use of the Westchester County / Sustainable Westchester app for 'Recycle Right.' Schedules and information about Yard Waste is given on the app. Content on the app and through the eNews from the Village Conservation and Environmental Advisory Committee encourages residents to mulch leaves in place and use the leaf mulch as ground cover.



Food Waste

Drop-off

The Village participates in a residential food waste program with drop off at A.V. Veteran Park in the northeast corner of the Village. The location is adjacent to the upcoming new DPW facility which is expected to increase use of the drop-off.

Ardsey is one of six Villages in the Town of Greenburgh teaming up with local partners to divert food scrap waste for composting to soil. The program launched in January 2018. Ardsley Conservation and Environmental Advisory Committee (CEAC) established an active partnership with neighbor CACs and the Greenburgh Nature Center (GNC) to work with the Town of Greenburgh DPW on the program.

There is signage on site that provides guidance as pictured below — along with information on the village website — on which items are acceptable and unacceptable. Residents are informed on how-to sort materials and are asked to adhere to these guidelines. This program offers residents opportunities to purchase food scrap / compost bins and educates the community on composting to soil.



Food scrap bin and tote sales to Ardsley residents increased in 2019/20 and additionally many residents purchase bins outside the program. See the document submission reporting bin sales near the drop-off site; listing is given by street for Ardsley's zip code, 10502.

CEAC is also working with GNC to measure the mass and volume of food scraps diverted from the County incinerator waste stream. See the submitted documentation.

Food waste is carted on a weekly basis to a local transfer yard for reloading and trucking to the nearest operating commercial composting facility in Ulster. As the program continues to expand and show demand as seen in Ardsley, the County is planning construction of a local facility near the primary waste incinerator in Peekskill. The food study completed by the County in February 2020 cited this work and motivated additional work on program expansion including curbside pick up subject to evaluation of emissions.

Curbside:

CEAC has also worked with the Town of Greenburgh DPW on planning and development for curbside pick up of food scrap waste for recycling to compost. A survey prompt received an enthusiastic response. See the documents submitted with the survey eNews and the response comments from over 100 residents in December 2019 and, after a reminder in February 2020.

Curbside planning will resume this summer utilizing Town and Village grant submissions in progress for a \$250K investment in equipment.

Backyard Composting

Residents are informed and encouraged to use backyard composters too through education and periodic community discounts on backyard composters. This action has the greeted impact in reducing emission from food waste.

Growing demand from villages like Ardsley has encouraged the County to explore erecting a more local composting facility. Information was provided via Village eNews; see the document submitted.

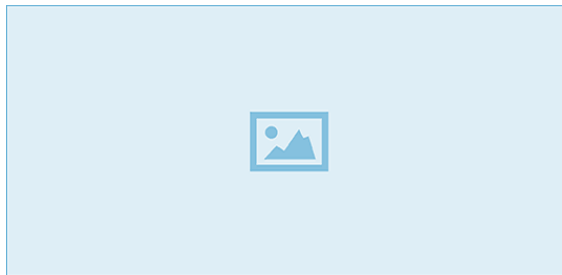

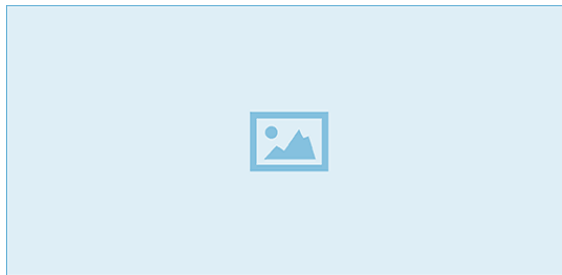
